







## Add Network Server to MAC

<p>On the Finder menu</p> <p>Select GO</p> <p>Select Connect to Server</p> <p>TIP: to see the Finder Menu Bar, Click anywhere on the Desktop. It will appear in the Top Left section of the screen</p>	
<p>In the Server Address bar</p> <p>Enter - smb://pcfnas.pcf.wustl.edu /Peds_Users/username</p> <p>Enter Peds_Users for PEDS</p>	
<p>Dovs_Users for DOVS</p> <p>OTO_Users for OTO</p>	
<p>Click the + sign to add the server to the Favorite Servers List</p> <p>Click Connect to connect to the server</p> <p>If SMB is not entered the MAC will assume an "afp" connection</p>
